A Busy Weekend and a great Family Day!



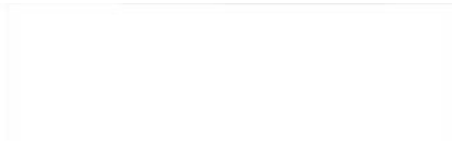
