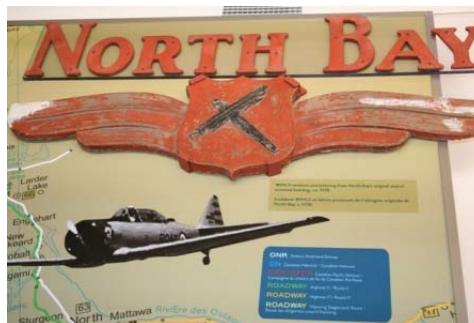
Coffee and Conversations Next Week – Thursday February 5th, 2009 at 2pm

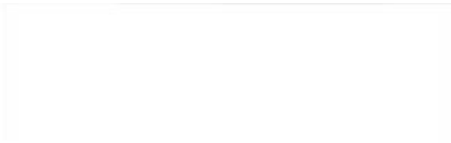
Aviation Expo in Celebration of 100 Years of Powered Flight.



Attention aviation buffs! This month marks the 100 year anniversary of the flight of the first powered aircraft; the Silver Dart in Nova Scotia.

Discovery North Bay will be hosting an aviation expo at Northgate Square on **Friday, March 6th and Saturday, March 7th**.

Pictured to the right; another amazing artefact on display at the museum. The original North Bay Airport (built before the Jack Garland Airport) sported the red North Bay sign and wings. Now mounted on a permanent display explaining North Bay's rich history as a transportation hub, these wings have seen many aviation firsts!
